PLANTWIDE HEALTH AND SAFETY CONSULTANT SERVICES REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

The Mahoning Valley Sanitary District (MVSD) is requesting proposals for professional consultant services to support MVSD's Plantwide Health and Safety Operations and third-party construction for the District.

The District is requesting services of a qualified health and safety consultant to assist in the development of an Environmental Health and Safety Program for the District's water purification and distribution and grounds maintenance operations, an assessment and recommendations of current safety practices, the development of a comprehensive employee safety manual, employees' training and third-party safety policy/training for all contractors performing work on District property.

Statement of qualifications should include information regarding the individuals/firm's history, education, and experience of key personnel, the individuals/firms previous work experience in health and safety including projects completed.
